## ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to all US residents 18 years of age or older, excluding members of fotofoto gallery. Any photographic medium including digital and alternative processes will be accepted. The maximum **height or width** of framed work cannot exceed **24 inches**. Free-standing pieces cannot be accepted.

## SUBMISSIONS

All entries must be submitted via the CaFE system, mail-in entries will not be considered. Images must conform to CaFE formatting standards, instructions can be found in the CaFE help section. ## FOR ACCEPTED ENTRIES

Approximately 30 photographs will be chosen for a four week exhibition in December 2016. Shipping information will be provided to artists selected for participation upon completion of the jury process. To ensure the cohesiveness of the exhibition, we request that work be framed in a simple black or dark color with neutral museum quality mats (no colors please).
