FOR ACCEPTED ENTRIES

Approximately 30 photographs will be chosen for a four-week exhibition in October 2020. Upon completion of the jury process, images will be printed by fotofoto gallery. No need for you to print, frame or ship your work. The exhibition will be installed salon-style in our beautiful gallery space.
