PHOTOGRAPHY

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to all US residents 18 years of age or older, excluding fotofoto gallery artists. Any photographic medium including digital and alternative processes will be accepted. The maximum **height or width** of framed work cannot exceed **24 inches**. Free-standing pieces cannot be accepted.

SUBMISSIONS

All entries must be submitted via the CaFE system. Mail-in entries will not be considered. Images must conform to CaFE formatting standards. Instructions can be found in the CaFE help section.

FOR ACCEPTED ENTRIES

Approximately 30 photographs will be chosen for a month-long exhibition from **February 4 - March 6, 2021 to be hung in our gallery and also online on our website**. Shipping information will be provided to artists selected for participation upon completion of the jury process. To ensure the cohesiveness of the exhibition, we request that work be framed in simple black or white frames with neutral museum quality mats (no colors, please). All framed pieces must be wired.

ABOUT fotofoto Gallery

Her work has been exhibited at Soho Photo Gallery, University of Maryland Global College, The Center for Fine Art Photography, Center for Photographic Art, Washington County Museum of Fine Arts, and the Biggs Museum of American Art. In 2018, her series, *The Emotional Landscape*, was exhibited at the Griffin Museum of Photography. Her work is in the collection of the National Park Service.
