

## ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to all US residents 18 years of age or older, excluding fotofoto gallery artists. Any photographic medium including digital and alternative processes will be accepted. The maximum height or width of framed work cannot exceed 24 inches. Free-standing pieces cannot be accepted.

## SUBMISSIONS

## FOR ACCEPTED ENTRIES

Approximately 30 photographs will be chosen for a month-long exhibition from **February 3 - March 5, 2022 to be hung in our gallery and also online on our website.** Shipping information will be provided to artists selected for participation upon completion of the jury process. To ensure the cohesiveness of the exhibition, we request that work be framed in simple black or white frames with neutral museum quality mats (no colors, please). All framed pieces must be wired.
